- Clear the sink and sanitize it thoroughly.
- Empty out the dish washer and run a cleaning cycle.
- Empty out cabinets/drawers, wipe them all down and organize.
- Wipe down small appliances like microwave, mixer, and coffee maker.
- Scrub down the oven and stovetop.
- Clear the pantry, toss expired foods, and wipe shelves.
- Clear the fridge/freezer, toss expired foods, and wipe interior/exterior.
